

The College Counseling Process at Horace Mann School

The College Counseling Process is an important piece of the 11th and 12th-grade years at Horace Mann School. Parents and students begin the process in the fall of 10th grade with materials from the College Counseling Office and in the spring with a College Planning evening. Students are assigned a College Counselor (different from the Academic Advisor) and meet with that person throughout the process. HM students over the years have gone on to attend hundreds of different colleges and universities and report that the background they received at HM more than prepared them for the challenge.
